RR SMITH FOUNDATION HELPS NEW TEACHERS WITH A GUIDE TO A SUCCESSFUL START-UP

"I got hired on the second day of school to teach a grade 7 class, and I had never started my own class before...I felt kind of lost, they try to support you, but they just throw you in there, and having a workshop would really help..."

Most early career teachers accept a wide variety of assignments, usually on short notice. This can lead to an overwhelming preparation load: learning what to teach, and how to teach it, gathering and making the resources for instruction, struggling to differentiate, while adapting to each new school context.

The solution? Workshops and resources for early career teachers

"The beginning of a new school year is both exciting and terrifying as a new teacher. Nothing can truly prepare you for the challenges, but without Start UP, my first year teaching would have been utterly overwhelming. Beyond the amazing unit plans and creative lesson ideas, Start UP gave me confidence in myself."

The Start UP! Your Class Cooperative is a BC based non-profit, formed to support early career teachers by providing beginners' teaching guides to the subjects/topics needed for an assignment, with suggestions about strategies, plans and web-based resources.

Support from the RR Smith Foundation

The RR Smith Foundation funding has enabled the printing handouts and copies of 'The First Week of School', a

how-to book for intermediate teachers. These have been used to support the 'Start UP! Your Class Successfully' workshops.

The Next Steps- Two videos have been produced so far

The main effort now is to record Start UP! workshops on video. This will enable more early career teachers to access them, especially those who are hired during the year, or on short notice. JERICHO ROAD PROJECT-INTO ALL THE WORLD

I am very happy about the help that the R.R. Smith Foundation has given to the Jericho Road Children's Project through the years. It has been a big help with the education of the young men who have made our project their home. Of our beginning group we still have with us 7 of the original group. One is working with us as a mentor and the nurse, another has completed his course and will begin to work as he turns to Kampala. One is reaching the end of his course in journalism. Another young man is nearly completed his course in teaching Kiswahili in secondary school. One young man has some time to finish his course in building and construction. The teacher told us he is doing well. Two are taking courses in the local university. One is into Information Technology and the other is into videography and business administration. There are 10 on the outside working at jobs where they support themselves. These seem to be doing well.

Without your help we could not possibly done this tertiary education and vocational programs. We still have 7 in the primary secondary programs. One boy was so excited as he was the first of his family to have completed grade 7. He got good marks and is excited about going to secondary in this new term. We feel these remaining boys will be able to find their places in society without going back to the streets.

As I am 81 I will be returning to Canada at the end of April but the man who was my manager has now begun his own project under the community based organizations. He and I have worked together for a number of years and I feel he will carry on in his own ways to supply a good home for children from the streets. He has many ideas he is working on to find money to work out this new project. We have new facilities on a river. I will let him tell you about his dreams.
